### One+ Talent Show

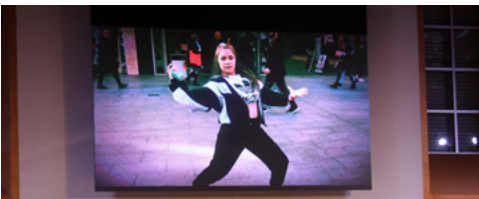

### Eddie Woo Visits Golden Grove High School

Eddie Woo, Australia's Local Hero for 2018, visited Golden Grove High School and spoke to more than 600 students and teachers from over 30 different local schools. Arguably Australia's most famous Mathematics teacher, Eddie Woo makes Maths fun. As the head Mathematics teacher at Cherrybrook Technology High School, the largest secondary school in New South Wales, Eddie started posting videos online in 2012 for a student who was sick with cancer and missing a lot of school. Before long, he was sharing the videos across the country and beyond. Wootube now boasts more than 100,000 subscribers and has attracted more than eight million views worldwide and counting. With infectious enthusiasm, Eddie's caring approach to teaching destigmatises Mathematics as an inaccessible and difficult subject.

Eddie entertained the audience for 75 minutes through three key themes:

- Maths should be fun and include elements of play
- Maths is better when it is done in teams (collaboration)
- Maths can be used to tell a story (i.e. Maths helps us to better understand the world around us).

The school was very pleased to be chosen as one of two secondary schools to host Eddie Woo during his visit to South Australia.
