WHAT IS THE LEARNING CENTRE?

The Learning Centre is located in Room F15. The Learning Centre offers curriculum support for a range of students at Golden Grove High School including:

- Students with a Negotiated One Plan (OCOP)
- Students who have been identified as requiring support with their learning
- Students at Risk
- Students are prioritised at Year 7, 8 and 9 if identified as below the majority of NAPLAN benchmarks
- Students placed in the Flexible Learning Options Program (FLO)
- Students with an Individual Education Plan (IEP)
- Students under Guardian of the Minister (GOM)



Through providing differentiated and targeted curriculum and learning support, the Learning Centre aims to achieve Success for All that fosters the school's values and supports students in developing their learner dispositions to become life-long learners and ready for the transition from school.

WHO USES THE LEARNING CENTRE?

Students may require assistance in clarifying their mainstream curriculum tasks and support in differentiating assignments.

The Learning Centre is not a behaviour modification area and all students are expected to take responsibility for their learning.

The English support classes are facilitated and taught in The Learning Centre.

Learning Centre Staff encourage all students to attend mainstream classes by supporting them with various subjects in the classroom.
