	Must have a total of 16 units selected.
	Students select a total of elective 8 subjects for the year. The order is important as the timetable is based on the preference order.
	Students must have 6 subjects per semester selected.
	Students who have submitted a VET application are still to choose 6 subjects per semester.
	Students MUST select an English for a full year.
	Activating Identities and Futures (AIF, replacing Research Project) is a semester subject. Students must select it in either semester 1 or 2.
	You MUST select a Mathematics subject for semester 1 and are encouraged to study a full year of Mathematics. If you wish to study any Mathematics at Stage 2 you must have studied a full year at Stage 1.
	If you are selecting Mathematical Methods , you must select A , B and C , it will count as 3 subjects If you are selecting Specialist Mathematics you must also select Mathematical Methods A, B and C, this will count as 4 subjects.
	If selecting a subject listed with a (full year), it will count as two units.
