#### Please note

If you are considering studying at an interstate university you need to check their specific conditions of entry as these may be different, for example many Eastern State Universities require a Stage 2 English/EALD subject. The following courses attract 'Adjustment Factor'— English, English Literary Studies, Japanese, Mathematical Studies, Specialist Mathematics and Spanish.
