## INSTRUCTIONS

- ✓ All students study 14 subjects in the year; 7 subjects in each semester.
- ❑ Students need to select **one subject from each line in both semesters. Making 14 selections in total** from the Year 10 Subject Selection Grid.
- ❑ Students **MUST** select an English for 2 semesters on the same line throughout the year. A recommendation has been made on DayMap for the most appropriate English level to select.
- ❑ Students **MUST** select a Mathematics for 2 semesters on the same line throughout the year. A recommendation has been made on DayMap for the most appropriate Maths level to select.
- ❑ Students **MUST** select Science for 2 semesters on the same line throughout the year.
- ❑ Students **MUST** select Exploring Identities and Futures (EIF – formerly PLP) and History for 1 semester each in either semester.
- ❑ Students **MUST** select a Health and Physical Education (Sport, Lifestyle or AFLW) in either semester. Physical Education can be chosen as an additional elective but only in the opposite semester.
- ❑ Students then select 5 elective semesters of classes they wish to study.
- ❑ If selecting a subject listed with (year) you must select it for Semester 1 and 2.
- ❑ If selecting a subject listed with (semester) you can only choose this subject once in either semester.
- ❑ All other subjects can be chosen in either semester 1 or semester 2 or for a full year.
- ❑ Students are reminded they can only choose a maximum of 3 subjects from any one curriculum area.
- ❑ Students are required to select **two additional next preference subjects** which may be used if another subject choice cannot be allocated.
- ❑ When you have completed this document, enter your chosen subjects into Web Preferences.

### Additional Subject Considerations

- ✓ Music; Spanish; Japanese; Special Interest Dance are all **full year subjects** and therefore must be chosen in both semesters.
- ✓ Special Entry - Dance students are not required to select Health and Physical Education.
- ✓ To select Engineering (Campus) – students must achieve a C+ or better in Mathematics and Science in 2023.
- ✓ Students interested in studying Peer Support Pre or Student Leadership must also submit a written application using
